QUESTIONS TO ASK FOR SETTING UP A CASINO EVENT

- **How many people in your group?** This will help to determine how much casino equipment you will need for the event.
- **What is the group ratio of Men to Women?** (50% Male & 50% Female or 60% - 40% etc). This will determine what type of equipment you will need to satisfy your guests.
- **Will you be offering any prizes to win for the event?** (This is encouraged to do because it allows World Class Casino Entertainment the opportunity to get back the “Chips” at the end of the evening. Also, its more fun to play when prizes are involved!
- **What is the exact location of the event** and where will the equipment “Load – in” be? Is the location upstairs or downstairs? (with stairs add \$80.00 extra for crew labor).
- **What is the earliest time we can arrive?** Also, what time does the equipment need to be set up by? What type of attire do the dealers need to dress for? What is the event theme?
- **What kind of ending would you like?** (Raffle, Auction or High – Roller list)? If you ask all these questions the first time out it will result in a successful casino evening. ENJOY!

QUESTIONS YOU MAY WANT TO CONSIDER REGARDING YOUR CASINO NIGHT:

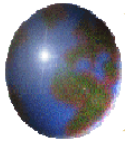
● **Q: HOW MUCH MONEY CAN MY GROUP RAISE WITH A CASINO NIGHT?**

A: Each group is different, and there is no way to give an exact figure to this question. However, there is a way for you to develop a fairly accurate estimate. First, you want to set a realistic goal for the amount that you want to raise. Then, estimate how many people are expected to attend. In order to maximize your profits, you will need to determine what the costs of your event will be. Ideally, you want to raise enough money before the event to cover these costs. (i.e. If your costs are \$5000 and you know that 100 people will come, you might want to charge \$50 or more per ticket to cover your costs and start the night with a profit.) Another suggestion would be to solicit organizations, business owners, etc. to “sponsor” each game table.

● **Q: WHAT SHOULD WE DO TO PROVIDE PRIZES FOR THE GUESTS?**

● **A:** In order to have a successful fundraiser, many expensive prizes are not essential. However, prizes may often help to increase the sale of vouchers. If purchasing prizes is not within your budget, you can once again look to the businesses in your community and request a donation. More often than not organizations are more than happy to help as long as they receive acknowledgement for their donation.

● There are many other factors involved in running a successful Casino Night Fundraiser that cannot be properly explained in writing. That is why before attempting such an event, World Class Casino Entertainment would recommend a meeting so that we may give you proper guidance on how to reach your goal.

EVENT ENDING DESCRIPTION

RAFFLE

- * In the beginning of the casino party, your guests will be given a casino voucher (shown below) worth whatever value you designate it to be (\$500.00, \$1,000.00 etc). Your guests will take that voucher to any gaming table and hand it to the dealer. The dealer will give your guests their casino chips. Your guests can then test their “Strategies” at any of the gaming tables for three hours. At the end of the three hours, the dealer will total each players money won for the evening. Your guests will then be given one “Raffle Ticket” for every \$200.00 won in chips. The ticket has two parts. Your guests will keep one half and put the other half into a raffle drum or fishbowl. You will then “Draw” for the different prizes **THAT YOUR COMPANY HAS PROVIDED.**

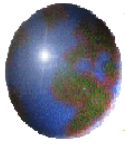
AUCTION

- * The casino party will start the same way as above. However, instead of cashing in for the raffle tickets, the dealer will instead write out a “Casino Check” written out for the amount won. Your guests will then be able to “Bid” on the different prizes **THAT YOUR COMPANY HAS PROVIDED.** There will be no change given back from the casino check. Therefore, your guests will only receive “One” chance per casino check.

HIGH ROLLER LIST

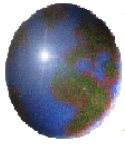
- * At the end of your casino event your guests will “Cash in” at any gaming table. The dealer will write the guest name and amount won on a list. The totals are then given to the host or hostess of the party and he or she will determine who won the most “Casino Money” and designate the prizes accordingly. You can have the “Top” winner take all or have a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winner.

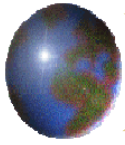
George Thomas, a terrific tribute of both Elvis Presley and John Travolta!
